International Court of Justice judicial review of decisions of Security Council

In the present article the author considers the problem of judicial review performed by the International Court of Justice over the decisions of Security Council. Dramatic increase in the activity of the Security Council since the beginning of 1990th has provoked intensive debates on the limits of its powers, its accountability and judicial control of its actions. The author analyzes the provisions of the UN Charter and relevant practice of the International Court of Justice including its decision in Lockerbie case which shows formal and conventional limits of the jurisdiction of the ICJ. It is obvious that the ICJ cannot perform a full judicial review of the decisions of the Council, which implies the annulment of its decisions.
